

### Supplement to EEO Report

At staff request this Report is being supplemented with additional information at staff request. As can be seen below, the Licensee is active in community outreach.

Job Fairs- Two Job Fairs were attended in 2020. The Business & Home Show (3/6-7, 2020) and The Tri-County Tech Career Fair (10/23/2020). Attached hereto is the copy of the Company poster used at the company's booth and a copy of the employment handout and job application which were available at the booth.

Shadow Day- The Licensee was a participant in the Junior Job Shadow Day which was held on March 9, 2020. This event was put on thru Bartlesville High School. Attached hereto is email confirmation of the event and the Licensee's participation.

Internships- Attached hereto is a screenshot of the Licensee's website which clearly show ongoing internship program. From 5/26 thru 8/ 7/ 2020, the Licensee hosted Trey Sumpff from Rogers State University as one of its summer interns. In March of 2020 Sawyer Brewster at Bartlesville High School began an internship but it was cut short when the local schools were shut down due to COVID-19. For year 2019-2020, the Licensee hosted C.J. Downing from Rogers State University and Shane Simpson from Bartlesville High School. Addition interns over the year 2018-2019: Jarrett Jones from Wesleyan Christian School, Daniel Fleming from Rogers State University and Calvin Johnson from Bartlesville High School. 2017-2018: Garrett Giles from University of Missouri (now the Licensee's News Director), Jacob Gailey from Caney Valley High School and John Cone from Bartlesville High School.

Scholarship Awarded. Every year the Licensee presents a scholarship to a Bartlesville High School Senior. This was given on 5/4/2020 virtually due to COVID-19. On 5/12/ 2021, a scholarship was awarded by the Licensee in person.

Class Days- Attached is the Class Days letter that goes out to the schools in January to get them scheduled. For Class Days, the Licensee general has tours where students come in to the studios and go on the air. As can be seen the attached email that was sent out when schools shifted to virtual or hybrid classes due to COVID-19, the Licensee utilized plexiglass, masks, Google hangout meetings and Zoom meetings to communicate with the students and produce their shows with them. Some came in person and some hosted virtually. The Licensee gets students who have an interested in broadcasting or communications and they love the hands-on experience. Last years dates for School Days were 3/28, 4/4, 4/18, 4,25, 5/9 and 5/16.

Student Tours- On 11/19/2020, the Licensee hosted the students from Barnsdall Elementary School. Student were able to go live on the air. Attached hereto is the email to the Licensee's staff giving the schedule for the day with our staff leading the kids through the various jobs at the Station. A on air sample of this visit is available upon request.

Teachers Assistance- During Summer 2020 Communications Teacher Jeri Melton (a former station employee) at Sequoyah Middle School, contacted the Licensee to develop a teaching video on broadcasting for her students. The Licensee worked with Ms. Melton on the video and she used it in the

classroom and via remote classroom lessons. Attached hereto is a thank you letter to the Licensee from Ms. Melton.

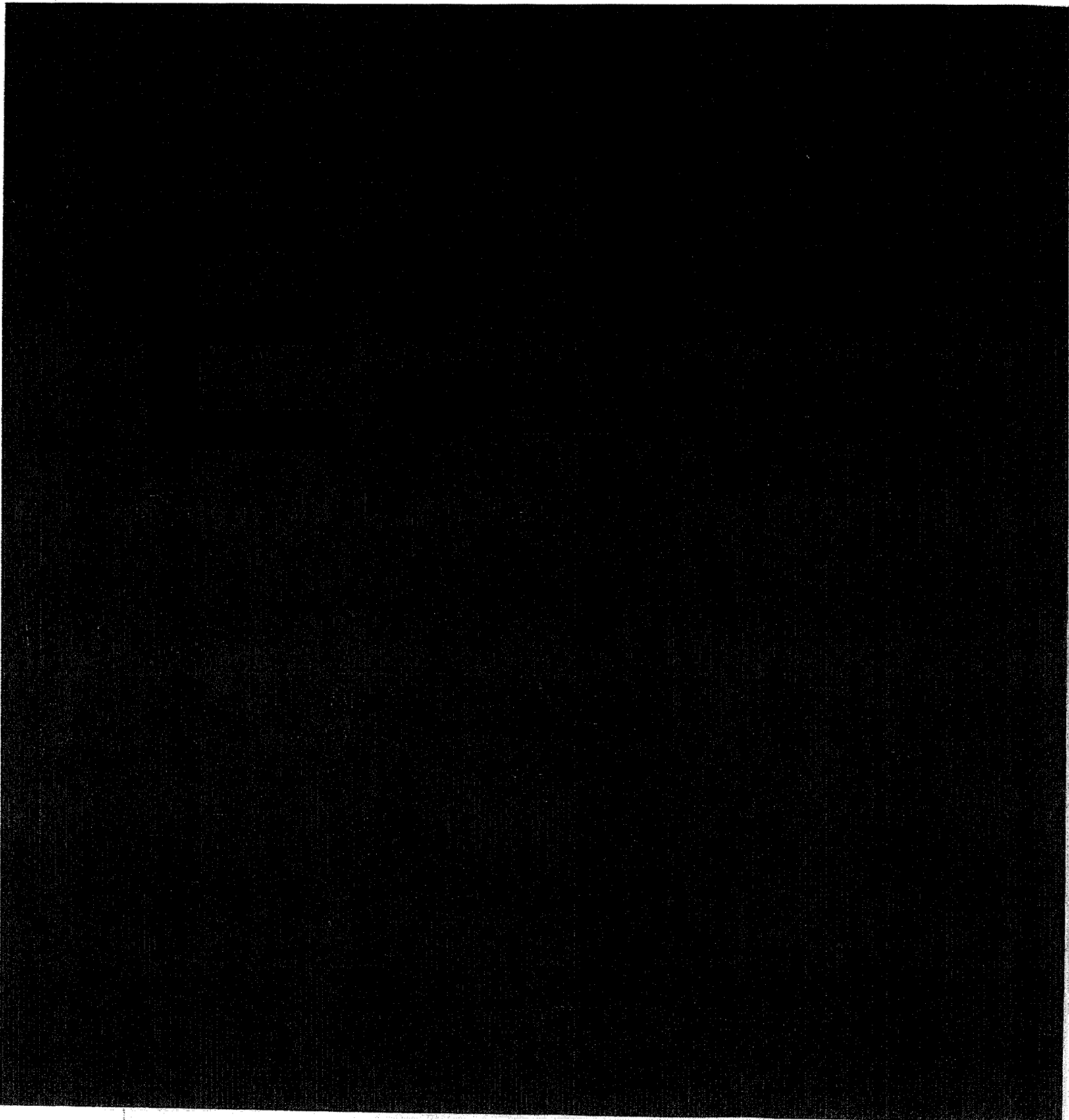

## Career Opportunities with KWON-KYFM-KRIG-KPGM

### *On-Air -*

**Announcers** - We hire full and part-time announcers to be on-air with each station. Job responsibilities include being able to read well, pronounce difficult words and names, have a friendly and pleasant disposition on-air, report news/weather/markets as needed, some writing ability, and computer skills.

**News Reporters** - These tasks are mainly handled by full-time personnel who share other responsibilities at the stations. Part-time employees may be hired to cover certain meetings, if they have strong writing skills.

**Sports Reporters** - Sports reporting is done by full and part-time employees. This requires a knowledge of sporting events, ability to report them accurately and with enthusiasm, flexible schedules, and training in broadcast equipment set-up.

### *Sales -*

**Advertising Representatives** - These positions are usually full-time, however, may be part-time under special circumstances. Sales people must be out-going, self-starters, with a drive to make many contacts a day. They are commissionable, with a guarantee and benefits. Personal transportation is used much of the time, with station vehicles available too. Integrity and a strong desire to assist the local business person is a must.

**Copywriting** - This is usually a shared responsibility of announcers or office staff. It requires creativity, accuracy, and the ability to work under deadlines. Word processing computer skills necessary.

**Commercial Production** - This is a shared responsibility of announcers and sales staff. Training done in-house on broadcast computer software.

### *Office -*

**Traffic & Billing** - This is done by full and part-time employees. Computer skills necessary with training on broadcast software. Accuracy, integrity, ability to meet deadlines are crucial in this department.

**Reception** - This is a full-time position with assistance from part-time employee and includes shared responsibilities in other area. Friendly phone skills, computer word processing, a people person to greet customers and listeners is very important.

**Public Service** - This is part-time and requires accuracy with strong word processing and Publisher design computer skills.

**Promotions** - Organizing station events is a shared responsibility between the sales staff and staff.

### *Engineering -*

**Chief Engineer** - This is a shared responsibility of station management. Major projects are outsourced to broadcast engineers with a specialty in the necessary job.
