

Online Public File Certification

West Central Ohio Broadcasting, Inc. (“Block”), licensee of WOHL-CD (the “Station”), Lima, Ohio, hereby certifies that except as described herein, the Station has timely placed in its online public file all the documents required to be placed in the file by 47 C.F. R. §73.3526 and otherwise has complied with the Commission’s public inspection file requirements in all material respects.

While WOHL-CD has substantially complied with the public file rules, it did encounter some difficulties with the public file uploads early in the current license term. Station staff believe that they uploaded the WOHL-CD public file materials on time but acknowledge that a number of documents show in the public file as being uploaded late on 6/23/2016. The Station has reviewed its records and is unable to definitively say whether these late uploads were due to technical issues, inadvertent staff oversight, or whether for some reason the original documents were removed and replaced. Under Block corporate policy, when a station becomes aware of late filed documents, employees are required to review the situation and make any needed corrections to station processes to ensure timely uploads going forward. Block notes that since second quarter 2016, the Station has uploaded all issues programs lists, children’s programming materials, and EEO Public File Reports on time with the exception of one commercial limits certification in first quarter 2019 and materials that were filed one day late in first quarter 2017.

WOHL-CD requires its employees to comply with all FCC rules, including the rules for the political public file. Employees are trained on FCC political public file compliance and the Station’s political public files are reviewed for completeness and timeliness. Nevertheless, while the Station has substantially complied with the political public file requirements, some documents were uploaded to the political public file outside of Block’s requirement that all documents be uploaded within one business day. Block will continue to work to ensure that all political public file materials are uploaded in a timely manner.
