Public File Exhibit (KSFX)

During the course of preparing the instant renewal application, licensee reviewed the station's online public inspection file ("OPIF") and discovered some discrepancies. Licensee noted that, in the past two years, some political documents were not uploaded immediately due to a misunderstanding that such documents were supposed to be uploaded after the subject advertisements had run.

Licensee also discovered that its quarterly issues/programs ("I/P") lists for Q4 2013-2016, which pre-dated the online public file, and Q1 2020 were missing from the OPIF, and that some more recent I/P lists were uploaded late. Licensee also noted that its 2017-2018 EEO Public File Report was uploaded late (by only a few days) and its 2018-2019 EEO Public File Report was missing. The missing documents have since been uploaded, except for the Q4 2013 I/P list which could not be located.

Licensee was under the impression that documents were being uploaded to the OPIF in a timely manner by the employees charged with its maintenance, when they in fact were not. To ensure OPIF maintenance requirements are met going forward, Licensee has taken corrective action, including designating a dedicated employee to be responsible for coordinating the timely preparation and uploading of required documentation and ensuring that station management is involved in this process.
