**Request to Modify Current Special Temporary Authority for
Operations on Displacement Channel with Temporary/Interim Antenna**

WNYT-TV, LLC (“Licensee”), the licensee of a digital replacement translator assigned to Glens Falls, New York (the “Glens Falls DRT” or “DRT”), hereby requests to modify its current Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”) to broadcast on Channel 28 (the “Channel 28 STA Request”) pursuant to the attached parameters. *See* FCC File No. 143694. (Because the FCC LMS system does not appear to allow for a modification to an existing STA, this request appears in the FCC LMS system as a new STA, though the Licensee does not currently expect to require an additional amount of time beyond the term of the current STA.)

Licensee has a displacement permit to operate the DRT on Channel 28 at its current location, which expires as of July 3, 2021. *See* FCC File No. 000053982. In late April, the Commission granted the DRT special temporary authority to operate on Channel 28 using a temporary antenna (Dielectric brand DLP-10B/VP). Upon further technical review, it has been determined that the underlying April STA request mistakenly provided an incorrect height for this temporary antenna. Accordingly, the Licensee is hereby seeking to modify (or supersede) its existing STA in order to update the antenna height (and effective radiated power) so that the DRT may continue to operate on Channel 28 until such time as it may begin permitted operations -- which is currently expected to occur no later than July 2021.¹

¹ To the extent necessary pending FCC action on this request, the Station also hereby notifies the Commission that it has commenced temporary operation under Section 73.1615 of the Commission's Rules pursuant to the parameters herein specified in order to provide broadcast coverage within its permitted Channel 28 contour for up to 30 days.
