

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The K275CE Construction Permit (File Number 93288) contains several Special Operating Conditions:

- 1. The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.*
- 2. Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.*
- 3. K275CE (FACILITY ID No. 145044) WILL NOT COMMENCE OPERATION ON CHANNEL 275D WITH FACILITIES AUTHORIZED IN HEREIN UNTIL KLXF(FM) (FACILITY ID No. 43333) COMMENCES OPERATION ON CHANNEL 213A WITH THE FACILITIES AUTHORIZED IN BPED-20170309AAL AND A LICENSE WILL NOT BE GRANTED FOR K275CE ON CHANNEL 275D WITH FACILITIES AUTHORIZED HEREIN UNTIL A LICENSE IS GRANTED FOR KLXF(FM) ON CHANNEL 213A WITH THE FACILITIES AUTHORIZED IN BPED-20170309AAL.*

The Association For Community Education, Inc. ("Association") complies with, or agrees to, the condition as follows:

1. Association in coordination with other users of the site agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna, from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
2. Form 350 is being filed prior to commencing program test operations.
3. KLXF(FM) Facility ID No 43333 commenced operation with the facilities authorized in Authorization BPED-20170309AAL and applied for and has been granted a license to cover such authorization as seen in FCC File Number 0000106732.
