

Amended Online Public Inspection File Certification

Bethany Church (“Bethany”) uploaded into the online public inspection file of WLFT-DT (the “Station”) records of requests for political broadcast time, quarterly issues/program lists and children’s television programming reports during the Station’s 2013-2021 license term. Not all of those required filings were made, some were incomplete and others were made untimely, partly as the result of catastrophic rains and flooding in 2016 that destroyed thousands of homes and surrounded the Station, and Bethany’s relief efforts for flood victims that continued for more than a year thereafter, as described in an article available at [www.deseret.com/2016/8/19/20594341/faith-based-groups-mobilize-to-aid-louisiana-flood-victims](http://www.deseret.com/2016/8/19/20594341/faith-based-groups-mobilize-to-aid-louisiana-flood-victims).

In late June and early July of 2021, Bethany recreated and uploaded its quarterly issues/programs lists for all of the quarters of 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 1Q2021 onto the Station’s online public inspection file.

Bethany has adopted written procedures to ensure future compliance with the regulatory requirements for the foregoing records. It has complied in all other respects with the Commission’s online public inspection file requirements.
