The EU's president, who currently is an Army Reservist, participated in several events sponsored by the US Army's "Army Pays" program which seeks to offer employment opportunities among soldiers transitioning out of the military back into civilian life.
2	Participate in other activities reasonably calculated to further the goal of disseminating information about broadcasting employment opportunities to job candidates	The EU's president sits on the Hollywood Chamber of Commerce and guides the chamber on employment needs in the local broadcast community as well as using the chamber to disseminate information about working in the broadcast industry more generally.
