

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO
LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION**

The instant amendment is being filed to update the renewal application (“Application”) filed for noncommercial educational television station WNPB-TV (“Station”) to provide additional information regarding its online public inspection file (“OPIF”) in response to questions from the staff.

In its Application, the Station indicated that it had late-filed six of its issues and programs reports. The six late-filed issues and programs reports covered the following periods:

1. Q2 2013 – April 1, 2013 through June 30, 2013 (uploaded October 1, 2013);
2. Q1 2014 – January 1, 2014 through March 31, 2014 (uploaded April 17, 2014);
3. Q2 2016 – April 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 (uploaded October 18, 2016);
4. Q3 2016 – July 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016 (uploaded October 18, 2016);
5. Q2 2017 – April 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017 (uploaded July 11, 2017); and
6. Q2 2018 – April 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018 (uploaded July 12, 2018).

The Station also disclosed in its Application that it had inadvertently failed to upload 3 issues and programs reports for the Station, and that it uploaded these issues and programs reports in May 2020 upon discovery. These three issues and programs reports covered the following periods:

1. Q1 2012 – January 1, 2012 through March 31, 2012;
2. Q2 2012 – April 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012; and
3. Q1 2019 – January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019.

The first two reports, covering Q1 and Q2 2012, fall outside of the current renewal period, which commenced on September 27, 2012, the date on which the Station’s last license renewal application was granted.

In addition to the above, the Station notes that the issues and programs report for the period from July 1, 2017 to September 30, 2017 (“Q3 2017”) was inadvertently uploaded to the “Additional Documents” subfolder of the “Station Information” folder, rather than to the “Issues and Programs” subfolder. Upon discovery of this matter in connection with the preparation of the Application, the Station uploaded the misfiled issues and programs list for Q3 2017 to the “Issues and Programs” subfolder of the OPIF. The Station did not reference the Q3 2017 report in the Application because it believed it had merely misfiled the report but, upon reviewing its OPIF in connection with the instant amendment, it appears that the Q3 2017 report may have been initially uploaded on July 11, 2017, which was one day later than required under FCC rules.

Lastly, the Station notes that it filed the issues and program report for the period from September 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 on January 15, 2021.
