Article I

The name of this corporation is **United Women of San Joaquin County**

Article II

This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.

The primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (“The Code”) and section 23701d of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, as amended.

The primary purposes of this corporation shall specifically be:

1. We are dedicated to empowering women by providing community informational support.
2. We support and encourage women to participate in civic engagement through peer mentoring.
3. Encouraging our community leaders and activist through their assistance in supporting community issues that impact health through education and labor for women in transition for ensuring a better quality of life.
4. It is our intent to disseminate information and operate a media production and broadcast facility subject to the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and other applicable local, state and federal laws.

Article V

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate of public office.

Article VI

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision of payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal revenue Code.
