

KSRV-FM Online Public Inspection File

During its most recent license term, KSRV-FM (Facility ID No. 35638) Ontario, OR, did not fully comply with certain online public inspection file (OPIF) requirements as provided in Section 73.3526 of the Commission's rules:¹

2019-2020 Annual EEO Public File Report – This report was inadvertently uploaded one day late (6/2/20).

2020-2021 EEO Public File Report – This report was timely filed and timely uploaded to the OPIFs of each of the other stations in the employment unit. Licensee was under the misunderstanding that it did not have to upload it to the KSRV-FM OPIF until October 1, 2021 because it is an Oregon station despite being in an employment unit with Idaho stations. As soon as this was explained, the station uploaded the report to the KSRV-FM

Q1-Q2 Issues/Programs Lists – During the preparation of this application it was discovered that these two reports, while timely prepared and placed in the station's former paper public file, inadvertently were not uploaded at the time that all of the legacy documents were uploaded at or before 3/1/2018. The licensee went back and located the old paper reports were

Political Files. A review of the political files reflects that there were 8-9 political files that were not uploaded within 24 hours/one business day, the standard the FCC has articulated for late uploads.
