

WCWF(TV) Hosting Arrangements

WCWF Licensee, LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of WCWF(TV), Suring, WI (Facility ID 73042); RF Channel 15), is filing this application to (1) commence ATSC 3.0 operations from WCWF(TV)’s current facility and (2) identify host station facilities that will be used to air WCWF(TV)’s programming in ATSC 1.0 format.

As indicated in the Form 2100 application, Licensee proposes to simulcast WCWF(TV)’s primary stream (affiliated with *The CW Network*) in ATSC 1.0 format on commonly owned WLUK-TV, Green Bay (FacilityID 4150; RF Channel 12).

Additionally, to minimize any loss of over-the-air programming available to ATSC 1.0 viewers that might otherwise result from WCWF(TV)’s transition to the ATSC 3.0 standard, Licensee also proposes to air WCWF(TV)’s multicast stream currently affiliated with *Comet TV* on WFRV-TV, Green Bay, WI (Facility ID 9635; RF Channel 22), pursuant to a written hosting agreement with Nexstar Media Inc.; the multicast stream currently affiliated with *Charge!* on WBAY-TV, Green Bay, WI (Facility ID 74417; RF Channel 23) pursuant to a written hosting agreement with Gray Media Group, Inc.; and the multicast streams affiliated with *Stadium* and *DABL* on WACY-TV, Appleton, WI (Facility ID 361; RF Channel 36) pursuant to a written hosting agreement with Scripps Broadcasting Holdings LLC.

The PSIP virtual channels for each of WCWF(TV)’s program streams described herein will remain unchanged. Accordingly, Licensee proposes to air WCWF(TV)’s streams in ATSC 1.0 on temporary host facilities as follows:
