On July 28, 2021, the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) released a Forfeiture Order, FCC 21-89, assessing forfeitures against a group of television station licensees for what the Order found to be violations of the FCC’s rules requiring that multichannel video programming distributors and television broadcast station licensees conduct retransmission consent negotiations in good faith. These forfeitures included one of \$512,228 assessed against Second Generation of Iowa, Ltd., licensee of KFXA-TV, Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

Second Generation is a party to a joint Petition for Reconsideration of the Forfeiture Order and its own Supplemental Petition for Reconsideration of the Forfeiture Order, both filed with the Commission on August 27, 2021.
