## October 2021 New FM Channel 212A Heart Butte, Montana Tribal Priority

In support of the applicant's claim for the Tribal Priority under the Fair Distribution of Service Analysis, the applicant certifies the following:

a) The applicant is a Tribal Applicant as defined in 47 CFR Section 73.7000.

The Blackfeet Tribe of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation of Montana is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act, 25 U.S.C. § 476, with all the powers of self-government and all the rights and responsibilities of a sovereign Indian Tribe. See also: *Indian Entities Recognized by and Eligible to Receive Services from the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs*, 84 Fed. Reg. 1200 (February 1, 2019).

b) The facilities proposed in this application will provide Tribal Coverage, as defined in 47 CFR Section 73.7000, of Tribal Lands occupied by the applicant Tribe.

The attached map exhibit depicts the proposed 60 dBu principal community contour as well as the boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation. The proposed 60 dBu contour covers an area of 784 square kilometers, of which 753 square kilometers (96%) are Blackfeet Tribal Lands.

The population on Tribal Lands which are covered by the proposed 60 dBu contours is 1207 per the 2010 Census.

The proposed 60 dBu contour does not cover any non-applicant's Tribal Lands.

c) The proposed community of license is located on Tribal Lands, as defined in 47 CFR Section 73.7000. The attached map exhibit shows that Heart Butte is located within the boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation.

d)	The proposed facility would be the first local Tribal-owned noncommercial educational transmission service at the proposed community of license.
	There are no other noncommercial educational transmission services at the proposed community of license, whether Tribal-owned or not.
