

**Application for Construction Permit  
Non-Commercial Educational FM Station**

**ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATIONS**

1. Nonprofit Educational Organization and Educational Purpose

Safe Harbor Broadcasting (“SHB”) is a nonprofit organization under IRS code 501(c)(3). As the attached Bylaws indicate, SHB was formed in 2018 with the express purpose of educating the Christian community in Homer, Alaska and the surrounding areas. SHB believes that a new noncommercial educational radio station licensed to Homer will provide a media outlet and a unifying voice for the entire community on the Kenai Peninsula.

In particular, following Commission approval of this application, SHB will broadcast: (a) Contemporary Christian and Russian Christian music to serve the local “Old Believers” community;<sup>1</sup> (b) teaching by local Pastors; (c) programming developed by students at Alaska Bible Institute; (d) a daily encouragement produced by the local Lutheran pastor; and (e) a prayer request program hosted by the local Episcopal priest. Other programs designed to meet SHB’s educational purpose also will be provided on the new station.

SHB also intends to introduce students at both the Homer High School and the Kachemak Bay campus of the University of Alaska to engage students to the field of broadcasting by providing internships and other opportunities.

2. Establishment as a Local Applicant

By this application, SHB intends to serve the community of Homer, Alaska. As indicated in the Articles of Incorporation, the physical headquarters of SHB is 950 Soundview Avenue, Homer, Alaska 99603.

3. Site Assurance

SHB has received assurance from South Central Radar, LLC, the owner of a tower located in Homer, Alaska, that SHB may mount its antenna on the top of the landlord’s tower. Contact information for South Central Radar, LLC is:

<sup>1</sup> The “Old Believers” are a group who split from the Russian Orthodox Church in the 17<sup>th</sup> Century. The current Old Believers’ ancestors fled persecution from the Russian government to Alaska, and Safe Harbor Broadcasting intends to utilize a new noncommercial radio station to provide a media outlet for the Old Believers community, among others.
