Oakridge Community Radio is submitting this exhibit to show our intent to provide educational programming under 73.503(a) of FCC rules.

Educational Programming

Oakridge Community Radio has plans to partner with the local school district, providing an educational radio program at the local high school. This program would give high school students the opportunity to learn about radio broadcasting, through hands-on experience. Students would learn how to use studio equipment, including a computer-based operating system. They would receive training on how to properly voice live and pre-recorded microphone breaks. Students would learn about FCC rules and regulations, and produce underwriting announcements, following guidelines.

Implementation of Unique Programming

Programming would feature a significant amount of music not heard on any other local station. Students and community members would have the opportunity to produce specialty programs, to serve unique niches within the local area. Locally-produced programs would include “student talk” where topics of interest to high school students would be discussed. Programs focusing on genres of music with appeal to high school students would be part of the weekly schedule. These programs would focus on dance music, clean hip hop, alternative & punk rock, brand new releases, and classic throwbacks. The local high school would have the opportunity to broadcast the play-by-play of sporting events, such as football and basketball games.
