Discrimination Complaint

Mike Adams, a former on-air talent in Boston, filed a charge of age discrimination against the company on April 19, 2016 with the Massachusetts Commission Against Discrimination (MCAD) (Charge Nos. 17WEM00903 (MCAD); 16C-2017-001198 (EEOC)). The matter settled during MCAD proceedings and dismissed on January 5, 2018.

Narrative Statement
