Dear Licensees/Permittees,

This concerns the above-referenced applications for extension of low power television digital construction permits. We are unable to grant these applications because of the existence of outstanding delinquent regulatory fee debts (“red light issue”). You are hereby notified that, unless you resolve your outstanding red light issue **within 30 days**, your applications for extension will be dismissed,<sup>1</sup> the stations’ construction permits will be automatically forfeited,<sup>2</sup> its licenses automatically cancelled,<sup>3</sup> and call signs deleted.<sup>4</sup>
