

**WORD OF GOD FELLOWSHIP, INC.**  
**Application for License Renewal**

**EXHIBIT RE: DATE OF ACQUISITION, SILENT STATUS  
AND STATION OPERATION**

Word of God Fellowship, Inc. (“WOG”) acquired low power television station KPXH-LD, Channel 25, Ft. Collins, Colorado (“Station”), on March 26, 2015. As set forth in the Station’s request for Silent STA (File No. BLSTA-20150626AAV) (“Silent STA”), the Station ceased broadcasting on June 10, 2015 because the Station’s tower site landlord informed WOG that the site no longer was available for use by the Station. The Commission never granted the Silent STA, for reasons that were not disclosed to WOG.

The Station was off the air between June 10, 2015 and May 27, 2016. On May 27, 2016, WOG filed a request for STA to operate the Station from a temporary site (File No. 0000010915) (“Engineering STA”), which the Commission granted on June 1, 2016. On November 4, 2016, WOG filed a request to extend the Engineering STA (File No. 0000016680), which the Commission granted on November 8, 2016. The Engineering STA expired on June 1, 2017, and WOG acknowledges that it did not file any additional requests to extend the Engineering STA.

On July 30, 2021, WOG filed an application for a construction permit, to change the Station’s channel to Channel 16, due to displacement (File No. 0000154860), which the Commission granted on December 2, 2021 (“Displacement CP”). On March 15, 2022, WOG filed an application for a license to cover the Displacement CP (File No. 0000186648), which currently is pending (“LTC Application”).

Accordingly, WOG certifies that the Station was silent for more than 30 days during the most recent license term (between June 10, 2015 and May 27, 2016), when it did not have access to a transmitter site location. However, the Station has been operating consistently between May 27, 2016 and the date of this application.

WOG is unable to certify that, since June 1, 2017, the Station has operated pursuant to the terms of its license or special temporary authority, but with the following caveat: between May 27, 2016 (the date set forth in the Engineering STA) and March 15, 2022 (the date that the Station commenced operating on Channel 16 pursuant to the Displacement CP and LTC Application), WOG was operating pursuant to the terms of the Engineering STA. WOG acknowledges that it should have requested extensions of the Engineering STA between June 1, 2017 and March 15, 2022, but did not do so, due solely to administrative oversight.

In recent months, a new WOG staff member has assumed day-to-day oversight over the operational status of all of WOG’s stations, including the Station. In particular, that staff member is paying close attention to the regulatory responsibilities of all of WOG’s stations, to ensure that oversights such as failing to secure extensions of engineering STAs do not happen in the future.

WOG submits that during the period it has been the licensee of the Station, the Station has

served the public interest, convenience and necessity. Accordingly, WOG submits that grant of this license renewal application is proper.
