Dear Licensee,

This concerns the requests to reinstate and extend the stations' licenses and extend silent authority filed by New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC, licensee of the above-captioned low power television stations (Stations). This letter also concerns the licensee's request for tolling of WAGC-LD's construction permit. We are unable to process the Requests without additional information. Therefore, please provide the following information for each of the Stations:

1. Since the stations went silent, a detailed accounting of all steps taken to resume operations including dates for each action and supporting documentation.
2. Since the stations went silent, a detailed accounting of any and all compelling circumstances outside of your control that prevented the resumption of service including dates of each circumstance and supporting documentation. Please describe how such circumstance(s) directly impacted the resumption of service.
3. For each station, a detailed accounting of what construction remains and a timeline/plan of how and when you expect to complete construction and begin operations.

Please file the above-outlined information in the form of an amendment to each of the Requests. You are reminded that all statements must be truthful and are being filed under penalty of perjury. Failure to submit this information within 30 days of the date of this letter will result in the dismissal of the Requests and cancellation of the Stations' licenses.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> As noted in a separate letter, the construction permit for KVFV has automatically been forfeited. To the extent the license is reinstated, NYSHC will need to file a new displacement application. See Letter from Barbara A. Kreisman to New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC (Mar. 28, 2022) available at LMS File No. 000053902. As part of its reply to this letter NYSHC should provide information regarding whether it plans to file a new displacement application and a timeline for doing so given the forfeiture of its construction permit.
