Motherlode of Mariposa History

Motherlode of Mariposa History is another collaboration with the Mariposa History Museum here in Mariposa, CA. Each week we present stories of Mariposa history accompanied by music from that particular era. Below is an example of our weekly history program.

The Motherlode of Mariposa History shares the story of San Francisco, Mariposa and the Gold Rush. Friday at 1 pm & Sunday Night at 7 pm.

In 1846, when soldier, explorer and future Mariposa resident John C. Fremont saw the watery trench that breached the range of coastal hills on the western edge of otherwise landlocked San Francisco Bay, it reminded him of another beautiful landlocked harbor: the Golden Horn of the Bosphorus in Constantinople, now Istanbul. Fremont used a Greek term to name it: Chrysopylae - in English, Golden Gate. In his 1848 "Geographical Memoir," Fremont added another layer of meaning: The rugged opening to the Pacific, he wrote, is "a golden gate to trade with the Orient." Hear the story through the music of the summer of love.

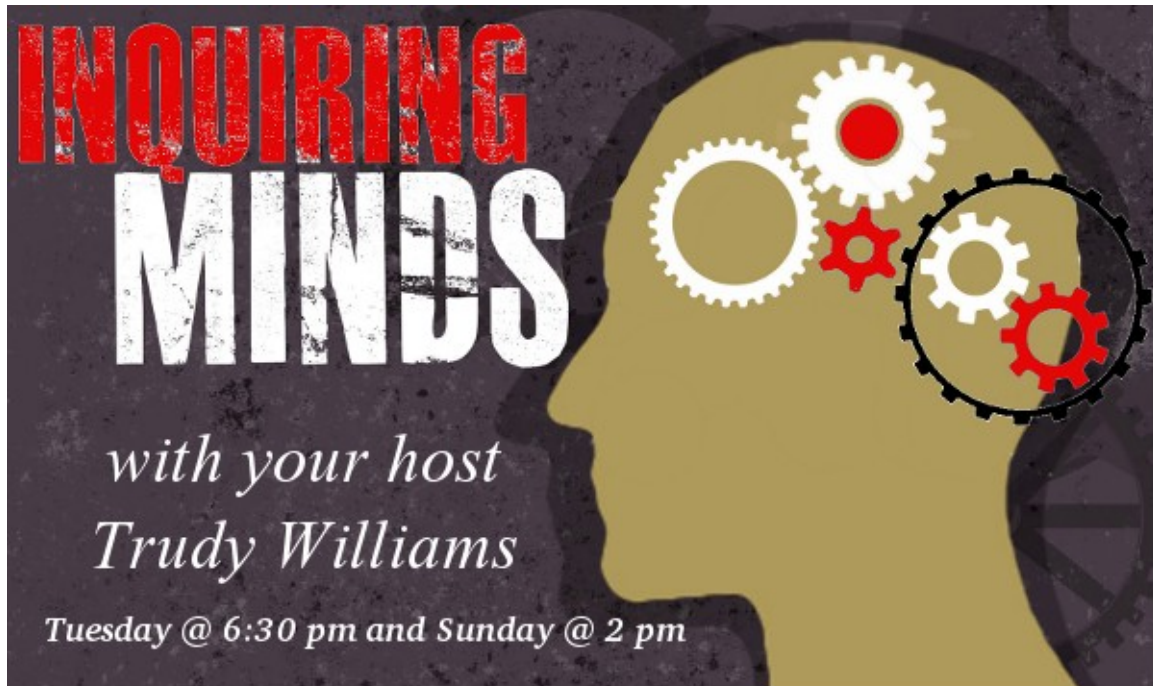


Inquiring Minds

KRYZ-LPFM Background:

In 2012 a small group contacted Kevin Bowman, then chairman of the Chrysalis Institute, to ask if the Chrysalis Institute would sponsor a low power radio project. The Chrysalis board members unanimously voted to sponsor them with the understanding that the radio group would form their own 501(c)3 nonprofit organization to host and support the radio station. After three years we received our FCC construction permit on Dec. 07, 2015. On Jan. 27, 2016 we received our IRS exemption letter for the Mariposa Community Radio. We were ready then to transfer ownership from the Chrysalis Institute to the Mariposa Community Radio but were told we had to wait the required five (5) years before we could transfer.

It has now been five years so we are soliciting the FCC to transfer ownership. Many of the former board members of the Chrysalis Institute are now members of the Mariposa Community Radio. We are an all volunteer organization. All donations and grant monies go to supporting the radio station, equipment upgrades and maintenance.
