



MINOR CHANGE APPLICATION  
KIJN-FM Farwell TX FACID 65458

COMPREHENSIVE EXHIBIT

This instant application requests a minor change to a licensed facility. This non-reserved band non-commercial educational facility requests an on-channel, in-class move to a new tower location, height and effective radiated power while specifying a new Community of License. The station will continue to operate as a non-commercial educational facility.

ANTENNA LOCATION

The proposed facility will operate on ASR 1263307 and reasonable assurance has been obtained from the tower owner, Grace Community Church of Amarillo, for the purpose of this application. The Proposed Allotment coordinates provided meet all of the mileage separation requirements for the channel and class specified.

COMMUNITY OF LICENSE CHANGE - 307(b) CONSIDERATION

Top O' Texas Educational Broadcasting Foundation (TOTEBF) seeks a minor change of city of license from Farwell Texas to Umbarger Texas maintaining the current operating channel and class of station KIJN-FM FACID 65458.

Requested Change:

The minor change of the city of license is pursuant to the provisions of MB Docket 05-210 which became effective on January 19th, 2007. This docket allows for city of license changes, under certain provisions, to be filed as a minor change application for Noncommercial Educational AM and FM broadcast stations. TOTEBF believes this application meets the provisions under MB Docket 05-210 for a change in authorized communities for KIJN-FM. The docket emphasizes the desire to avoid any losses of service to communities while providing the most efficient usage of spectrum.

This change of city of license is requested based on Priority 2, second full time aural service and the demonstration that there will be no grey or white area left behind in the allocation scheme upon the grant of this instant request.

Farwell Texas is currently the city of license for a total of three broadcast stations, KIJN-FM, KIJN (AM), and KICA-FM. If the authorized community for KIJN-FM is changed from Farwell Texas to Umbarger Texas, the community of Farwell will continue to receive 100% primary community contour service from the remaining signals licensed there, KIJN (AM) and KICA-FMBPD (FM), as well as primary community contour service from these stations:

With the abundance of community contour coverage in Farwell, there will be no grey or white area left behind as a result of this proposal.

The proposed new community, Umbarger Texas, has one current aural service authorized to it, and, therefore this request will be the community's second local service. Umbarger coverage by other signals is significantly less than that of Farwell, with the following other stations providing community contour service to it.

KACV-FM 89.9 Amarillo TX

Thus Priority 2 is met with a fair distribution of radio signals being accomplished by the proposal herein. Additionally, the proposed facility does not, and cannot ever be modified in such a way as to, cover any significant portion of the Amarillo Urbanized Area.

The following information is presented for consideration:

The area and population with the proposed 70 dB $\mu$  and 60 dB $\mu$  contours of the station:

The population within the current contours of the licensed facility of KIJJN-FM at Farwell is:

60 dB $\mu$ : 69,011 persons and an area of 6,802 sq. km,

70 dB $\mu$ : 12,017 persons and an area of 2,539 sq. km.

The population within the new proposed contours for the allotment at Umbarger will be:

60 dB $\mu$ : 52,994 persons and an area of 4,365 sq. km,

70 dB $\mu$ : 19,590 persons and an area of 1,527 sq. km.

The public interest supports a change of city of license from Farwell Texas which will remain well served with two local aural facilities; to Umbarger Texas which will benefit from its second local aural service.
