**Petition for Reconsideration and
Request for Reinstatement *Nunc Pro Tunc***

Gallup Public Radio (“GPR”) pursuant to Section 1.106 of the Commission’s Rules, hereby respectfully petitions the Commission for reconsideration of the Public Notice, *Actions*, Report No. PN-2-220310-01, released March 10, 2022 (the “Public Notice”), which dismissed the above-captioned application for a new noncommercial educational station.

In the Public Notice, *Media Bureau Dismisses Defective Singleton Applications Submitted in the November 2021, Filing Window for New Noncommercial Educational FM Stations*, DA 21-1516, MB Docket 20-343, released December 8, 2021, the Commission invited dismissed applicants to submit a curative amendment and to request reinstatement of their applications *nunc pro tunc*.

Concurrently with this petition, GPR is submitting an amendment to its above-captioned application to address the issue identified in the Public Notice. Specifically, GPR amendment corrects the typographical error that indicated the proposed community of license is not within Arizona.

As provided in the Public Notice, the Commission allows reinstatement of dismissed applications *nunc pro tunc*, where a minor curative amendment is filed in conjunction with a petition for reconsideration within thirty days of the dismissal of the application.¹

Accordingly, the amendment is submitted as a minor curative amendment pursuant to such policy. It is filed concurrently with the filing of this petition for reconsideration of the Public Notice dismissing the application. Under these circumstances, reinstatement of the application *nunc pro tunc*, as amended, is respectfully requested.
