
HSH Birmingham (WSES & WGWW) Licensee, LLC, licensee of WSES(TV), Tuscaloosa, Alabama (FID: 21258) (the "Station"), by its undersigned attorney, hereby provides notice that as the Station converts its channel 36 operation to the ATSC 3.0 broadcast television transmission standard (LMS #0000191494, granted June 21, 2022), its two multicast streams, Decades and Start TV, will be broadcast in the ATSC 1.0 format on WDBB-TV, channel 14 (.4 & .5), Bessemer, Alabama, licensed to WDBB-TV, Inc. WDBB-TV is also the host of the Station's primary stream, Heroes & Icons.

In addition, the Station was unable to complete its ATSC 3.0 conversion on June 23, 2022, as originally scheduled, due to technical issues. The new launch date has been scheduled for July 14, 2022 at 8:00 a.m., local time. Notice of this change has been provided to the local MVPD operator(s).
