

**FCC Form 303-S**  
**Public Inspection File**

As noted in its Discontinued Operations Disclosure, KDTV-CD, Santa Rosa, CA (the "Station"), was forced to cease operations for an extended period of time following the devastating Santa Rosa wildfires. Accordingly, the Station prepared and timely uploaded its Quarterly Issues/Program Lists, Children's Commercial Limits Certifications, and Class A Eligibility Certifications from 1Q 2018 To 1Q 2019 that reflect that the Station was silent during this time period.

The Station believes that it has generally met the requirement in Section 73.1943(c) of the FCC rules to post political orders to the online public inspection file "immediately, absent unusual circumstances." The Station is not aware of any political spot for which it did not post information to the public inspection file. In an abundance of caution, the Station reports the following:

- In August 2020, the Station received two non-candidate ads and uploaded information to the public file 5 and 6 days later.
- In June 2021, the Station received a non-candidate buy from Clean Up California, but did not upload information to the public file until September.
