

Children's Television Programming Reports

The Licensee has certified in the affirmative with respect to the various items in FCC Schedule 303-S pertaining to the Station's compliance with the Children's Television Programming Rules. The Licensee below notes the following circumstances related to certain of its Children's Television Programming Reports in order to correct inadvertent errors therein:

- From Second Quarter 2018 through Third Quarter 2019, the Reports indicate that the E/I symbol was not displayed as required during one program: El Campeón En Ti, which aired on the Station's multicast stream affiliated with the Telemundo Network. That representation was in error; the E/I symbol was, in fact, displayed as required in those instances.
- From Second Quarter 2018 through Third Quarter 2019, the Reports state that the Station aired 672 hours of programming on other than its main program stream (i.e., on its multicast streams). Station personnel incorrectly entered such information into the Reports. During such quarters, the Station aired programming on three multicast programming streams, meaning that the average number of hours per week of free, over-the-air digital video programming broadcast by the Station on other than its main program stream was 504 (three streams multiplied by 168 hours per week)—not 672—hours.
- In the 2019 Annual Report, Station personnel failed to respond to the question whether each episode of Digital Core Program 8 occurred between 6:00am and 10:00pm. The program aired at 8:30 a.m. and, as such, the question should have been answered in the affirmative.
