When attempting to file on behalf of MIPM a Resumption of Operations notice with respect to WFYI-LD (Facility ID187439, Indianapolis), the option to file was not available. The call sign was recently changed from W29EL-D. The station went silent on 08/03/2021 and the station commenced operations on 07/27/2022. The station resumed operations in ATSC 3.0 as stated in the pending license application (File No. 0000195812) to cover the station's construction permit (File No. 0000189050). Please note in the commission's records that the station is no longer silent.
