

Purpose of Report

The purpose of this filing is to provide additional information with respect to the Employment Unit's FCC Schedule 396 filed in LMS File No. 0000195894 (the "***Initial Report***"). The Licensee intends that the instant filing supersede and replace the Initial Report.

The Licensee timely filed the Initial Report when due in connection with the license renewal application for KCOY-TV. The Licensee has since become aware that station KCOY-TV (but *not* the Licensee company) was named in a discrimination complaint filed against the third-party provider of certain services to KCOY-TV pursuant to an existing Shared Services Agreement. The complaint was not initially identified by the Licensee because VistaWest California, LLC was not a party named in the complaint. Accordingly, out of an abundance of caution, the Licensee hereby amends its answer to the question regarding whether there have been any pending or resolved discrimination complaints involving the station during the license term from "No" to "Yes." Available details of the complaint in question are provided below.

Paula Lopez Ochoa v. NPG of California, LLC. On or around November 19, 2015, Ms. Paula Lopez Ochoa, an individual formerly employed as an anchor/reporter by NPG of California, LLC ("NPG"), filed the a complaint, captioned DFEH Matter Number 712128-195489, with the California Department of Fair Employment and Housing alleging various claims of discrimination (the "DFEH Complaint"). Station KCOY-TV was referred to therein. The DFEH Complaint was closed, and a right to sue letter dated November 19, 2015, was issued. On or around September 2, 2016, Ms. Lopez Ochoa filed a lawsuit in Santa Barbara Superior Court, *Paula Lopez Ochoa v. NPG of California, LLC*, Case Number 16CV03875. The case was settled and was subsequently dismissed pursuant to a request for dismissal filed by Ms. Lopez Ochoa's counsel on or around December 2, 2016.

The Licensee is aware of no other complaints alleging unlawful discrimination by KCOY-TV.
