### **Operations Certification**

As part of the incentive auction and repacking process, low power television station KZCS-LD was displaced and forced to go silent. The licensee ceased operations of the station on Channel 23 on May 6, 2019.

The transmit facilities for KZCS-LD are located on Cheyenne Mountain in Colorado. Early and continuing inclement weather during the 2019-2020 Winter season delayed delivery of the station's new transmitter and antenna to its remote transmitter site. Because of these delays, resumption of service did not occur until June 12, 2020. The licensee requested reinstatement of the license, given that the station was forced off the air due to circumstances beyond its control. KZCS-LD was displaced by the incentive auction and diligently pursued a new digital displacement channel. Accordingly, in its letter of June 17, 2020, the Media Bureau waived its rules and reinstated the license. The licensee recommenced operations pursuant to a covering license application on its displacement channel, Channel 18.
