

### **Notification of Operations with Licensed Auxiliary Facility**

The University of North Carolina, licensee of WUNC-TV (Facility ID No. 69080), hereby provides notice that as of October 5, 2022, the Station's ATSC 1.0 programming stream has (of necessity) been broadcast from its licensed auxiliary facility (see LMS File No. [0000081297](#)) because it has become technically impossible to operate WUNC-TV with its licensed main ATSC 1.0 facility (see LMS File No. [0000138116](#)). On October 5, 2022 a high VSWR condition developed with the main antenna system preventing the use of that antenna. On air operations were quickly restored with the licensed auxiliary facility (see LMS File No. [0000081297](#)).

Testing of the main antenna system has determined that a problem exists with the rigid transmission line above the 700 foot level on the tower. A tall tower crew is required in order to make the necessary repairs to the transmission line. That crew is expected to arrive at the site on or around October 17, 2022. While the station is operating with its authorized licensed auxiliary facility at its fully authorized power, the goal is to resume full power operations with WUNC-TV's licensed main facility as quickly as possible.

This situation only impacts WUNC-TV's ATSC 1.0 operations. The WUNC-TV ATSC 3.0 facility is not impacted.

The licensee will notify the Commission once full authorized operations from WUNC-TV's licensed primary facility have been restored.
