

### **Request for Special Temporary Authority**

WLII/WSUR License Partnership, G.P. (“Licensee”), licensee of WSTE-DT, Facility ID No. 60341, Ponce, Puerto Rico (the “Station”), respectfully requests special temporary authority to operate at reduced power because Site 4 of the Station’s Distributed Transmission System (“Site 4”) remains off-air due to damage caused by Hurricane Fiona.<sup>1</sup> Site 4 went off-air on or about September 18, 2022 and station engineers have not yet been able to restore operations.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, Licensee respectfully requests special temporary authority for Site 4 to remain silent until service can be restored.<sup>3</sup>
