

Public File

In preparing its license renewal filing, the Station conducted an audit of its online public file. It determined that the 4Q 2014 Commercial Limits Certification was uploaded on 3/26/2015.

Core Programming

As disclosed in its 2019 Children's Programming Report, the station did not claim credit for all of the Core programming that it aired during 4Q 2019, resulting in a short-fall for that quarter. The station aired well over the required 3 hours a week of Core programming. However, the station only claimed credit for the programming that aired as scheduled or aired with the appropriate notice of preemption or make-good. The station did not claim credit for Core programming that aired without the required notice of preemption or make-good. In 1Q 2020, the station aired significantly more programming than required (45 hours on the primary and 78 hours on the multicast channels). Thus, when averaged over a six-month period, the station aired 3 hours a week of Core programming.
