RE: License and Construction Permit
Expiration

Dear Former Licensee/Permittee:

This is with respect to the former analog low power television translator stations listed in the attached Appendix. Commission records indicate that you failed to file an application for license to cover prior to the stations' construction permit expiration dates.¹ Section 74.788(b) of the Commission's rules states that:

Any construction permit for which construction has not been completed and for which an application for license or extension of time has not been filed, shall be automatically forfeited upon expiration without any further affirmative cancellation by the Commission.²

As such, the construction permits were automatically forfeited.³

In addition, section 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules provides that:

After 11:59 p.m. local time, [][July 13, 2021], low power television and TV translator stations may no longer operate any facility in analog (NTSC) mode and all licenses for such analog operations shall automatically cancel at that time without any affirmative action by the Commission.⁴

³ In the stations' requests for tolling, the licensees stated that it "will not pursue further extensions for any of the [] digital permits that cannot be constructed by October 1, 2022." *E.g.*, LMS File No. 0000194785. On October 11, 2022, Media Bureau staff confirmed with counsel for the licensees that construction of the stations listed in the Appendix were not completed and that the licensees were no longer pursuing construction of those digital facilities. We also note that television stations located in the State of Alaska were required to file an application for license renewal by October 3, 2022. None of the stations' listed in the Appendix filed for renewal. Counsel to the licensees informed Media Bureau staff that failing to file license renewal applications for the stations was intentional as the licensees no longer intend to construct the stations' digital facilities.

Accordingly, pursuant to sections 74.788(b) and 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules,⁵ the construction permits for the stations referenced in the attachment have been **AUTOMATICALLY FORFEITED**, the licenses were **AUTOMATICALLY CANCELED**, and the stations' call signs **HAVE BEEN DELETED**.⁶ All authority to construct or operate the stations has **TERMINATED**. Furthermore, any pending applications **HAVE BEEN DISMISSED**.
