Introduction and Summary

This Statement has been prepared on behalf of *University of North Texas*, (“*Texas*”), licensee of Station KNTU(FM), McKinney, TX. *Texas* holds a Construction Permit, FCC File Number 0000193658, authorizing a minor modification for FM Station KNTU(FM) located at a registered supporting structure (SAR 1053099). The construction authorized in the Construction Permit (“CP”) has now been completed. Installation and adjustment of systems necessary to operate with the authorized new facilities into its antenna system has been accomplished. As such, this facility is now able to operate in compliance with the terms and conditions of its CP and all applicable FCC Rules and policies. KNTU(FM) is now operating according to *Automatic Program Test Authority*.

Satisfaction of CP Conditions

The KNTU(FM) Construction Permit is subject to 1 **Special Operating Condition**, which as discussed in the following paragraphs. *All Conditions have been complied with as of the filing of this Application*. Specifically:

FCC Special Operating Condition 1 stipulates that:

“Upon commencement of program tests in accordance with Section 73.1620, the licensee must cease use and request cancellation of the auxiliary facility authorized by BMLED-19920205KC due to a violation of Section 73.1675(a)(1). Alternatively, the licensee may seek modification of the auxiliary facility in accordance with Section 73.1675(c)(1) to bring it into compliance with Section 73.1675(a)(1). Documentation of compliance with this condition must be submitted with the Application for FM Broadcast License.”

Texas is preparing a minor modification application to specify operation at reduced ERP for its auxiliary facility in order to comply with FCC Rules. While waiting for the application review and approval process, *Texas* will cease use of the auxiliary facility. In the event that emergency operation becomes necessary, *Texas* will send an informal letter to the FCC within 24 hours as specified in §73.1680 of the Rules.
