WUNI Hosting Arrangements

UniMas Boston LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of WUNI(DT), Marlborough, MA, RF Channel 27 (Fac. ID 60551) (“WUNI”) is filing the instant application (1) to commence ATSC 3.0 operations from WUNI’s current facility and (2) identify host facilities that will be used to air WUNI’s programming in ATSC 1.0 format.

As indicated in the instant Form 2100 application, Licensee proposes to simulcast the WUNI primary stream (which broadcasts the Univision Network) in ATSC 1.0 format on station WNEU(TV), Merrimack, NH (Fac. ID 51864), licensed to NBC Telemundo License LLC, RF Channel 29.

Additionally, to minimize any loss of over-the-air programming available to ATSC 1.0 viewers that might otherwise result from WUNI’s transition to the ATSC 3.0 standard, Licensee proposes to air WUNI’s multicast streams in ATSC 1.0 format as follows: (a) the multicast streams affiliated with Bounce and Get TV on WFXT(TV), Boston, MA (Fac. ID 6463), RF Channel 34, licensed to Teton Opco Corp; (b) the multicast stream affiliated with Court TV on WSBK-TV, Boston, MA (Fac. ID 73982), RF Channel 21, licensed to CBS Television Licenses LLC; and (c) the multicast stream affiliated with Twist on WGBH-TV, Boston, MA (Fac. ID 72099), RF Channel 5, licensed to WGBH Educational Foundation. In each such case, Licensee or its parent company has entered into a multicast hosting agreement with the applicable host licensee or its parent company.

The PSIP virtual channels for each of WUNI’s program streams described herein will remain unchanged. Accordingly, Licensee proposes to air WUNI’s streams in ATSC 1.0 on temporary host facilities as follows:
