KNME-TV, Albuquerque, NM**

Online Public Inspection File

Regents of the University of New Mexico and Board of Education of Albuquerque, New Mexico, licensee of noncommercial educational television station KNME-TV, Albuquerque, New Mexico, reports the following with regard to the timely placement of certain items into the station's public inspection file. The KNME-TV online public inspection file is complete with all required items, but certain quarterly issues and programs lists were uploaded a few days late (or a few months late in three instances). Specifically, 1 list was uploaded 9 days late (2015 Q4); 3 lists were upload between 11 to 17 days late (2016 Q1; 2020 Q1; 2020 Q4); and 3 lists were uploaded between approximately 2 to 3 months late (2016 Q3; 2020 Q2; 2020 Q3). KNME regrets the brief delay in the upload of these items but believes that station's online public file is now complete and has been substantially compliant throughout the license term. In addition, certain annual EEO public file reports were uploaded late to the online public file during the current license term, but all required reports are now available in the online public file. As with the other items, personnel changes and turnover contributed to these late uploads but KNME has consolidated responsibility for the upload process. We will also note that two of the lengthier delays were Q2 and Q3 2020 during the height of the pandemic as we were transitioning many employees to working from home full-time and resources were limited and access to necessary information was at its most challenging point.
