

SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT

Entravision Holdings, LLC (“Entravision”) wishes to take this opportunity to clarify the Statement that it submitted on December 6, 2022, as an amendment to the Station’s renewal of license application, dealing with violations of the children’s television programming rules and arising from the broadcast of programming capsules with links to commercial matter that were not materially separated from educational programming. This was contained in Univision Network programming during the period from June 2016 through March 2017.

As explained in its Statement, Entravision was not informed by the Network at the time the violations may have occurred, and there was no reference to any such violations in the quarterly certifications from the Network to Entravision for the applicable periods of Q2 of 2016, Q3 of 2016, Q4 of 2016 and Q1 of 2017. The Network also did not at any point submit to Entravision amended quarterly commercial limits statements speaking solely to the applicable violations and specifying each applicable calendar quarter.

In its Commercial Limits Certification to affiliates for Q3 of 2017, after first stating that the commercial limits and children’s television rules were complied with for that calendar quarter, the Network included a statement that it had not been in compliance with the children’s television rules during the period from June 2016 through March 2017, owing to the capsules containing the URL for the *Mundo Lanugo* website. Entravision inadvertently overlooked this information due to the manner in which it was presented and only recently became aware of the potential inaccuracy of its previously submitted certifications. Due to the passage of time, Entravision is not able to independently determine if any violations actually occurred, nor can it take any actions to remediate them. Nevertheless, Entravision promptly updated the Station’s online public inspection file upon becoming aware of the information from the Network.
