Online Public Inspection File Certification

Imagicom Binghamton, LLC (“Imagicom”), licensee of WICZ-TV, Binghamton, New York, hereby certifies that except as described herein, WICZ-TV has timely placed in its online public inspection file all documents required to be placed in the file by 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526 and otherwise has complied with the Commission’s public inspection file requirements in all material respects.

Imagicom notes that the station changed ownership during the current license renewal term. Specifically, on August 1, 2022, the license for WICZ-TV was assigned to the station’s current owner pursuant to a long form assignment application. *See* FCC File No. 0000189170. Imagicom notes that because of the long-form ownership change, the current owners are not liable for any violations of the prior owners. However, out of an abundance of caution, Imagicom discloses that the prior owners failed to timely upload the 2015 Q3 Commercial Limits in Children’s Programming Certifications.

Imagicom requires its stations to comply with all FCC rules, including the rules for the political public file. Imagicom employees are trained on FCC political public file compliance before and throughout each election cycle and are provided with tools and checklists to assist with maintaining complete and timely records. WICZ-TV has complied with the political public file requirements, uploading required documents to the political public file as soon as possible, most within one business day. Imagicom has counseled the station on FCC political public file requirements and emphasized that all required materials must be uploaded immediately, meaning within one business day if possible.
