Request for Special Temporary Authority

Pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the Commission's rules, Cox Radio, LLC ("CMG"), licensee of WSBB-FM, Doraville, Georgia (Facility ID 11710), hereby requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for WSBB-FM to operate from an alternate antenna with facilities at variance from its licensed operations while repairs are made to the tower on which its existing antenna operates.

WSBB-FM's licensed facilities (BLH-20190802ABE) operate from a tower owned by the Board of Education, City of Atlanta (ASR 1028278) (the "BOE-Atlanta tower"). The BOE-Atlanta tower was damaged and repairs are scheduled to take place in February 2023. Due to the complexity of the repairs, WSBB-FM will need to temporarily cease operations from the BOE-Atlanta tower while the repairs are made.

While the tower crew works to repair the BOE-Atlanta tower, WSBB-FM proposes to move to an alternate antenna located on a tower used by WSTR-FM, Smyrna, GA (Facility ID 30822) that is owned by American Towers LLC (ASR 1206253). As the attached Technical Summary explains, the proposed STA contour will be located entirely within the current WSBB-FM licensed contour. CMG anticipates that repairs to the BOE-Atlanta tower will be complete by the end of February and WSBB-FM will be able to resume operation from its licensed site at that time.

CMG hereby requests Special Temporary Authority for WSBB-FM to operate with the facilities requested in the attached engineering Technical Summary.
