Amended Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule Exhibit
Oregon Public Broadcasting

K15KN-D, Roseburg, Oregon, Facility ID No. 50582, was silent pursuant to Special Temporary Authority from January 13, 2020, until February 3, 2020. *See* LMS File No. 0000100730 (Silent STA Request granted Jan. 27, 2020).

The input signal for K15KN-D was fed by K24FH-D, Glide, Etc., OR, Facility ID No. 50585. On January 13, 2020, K24FH-D was forced off the air because its tower fell as a result of ice accumulation.

On February 3, 2020, Oregon Public Broadcasting (OPB) was able to return K15KN-D to air through a temporary over-the-air feed from nearby commonly owned translator stations K11VI-D and K33LZ-D. On February 5, 2022, OPB filed a Notice of Resumption for Regular Operations for K15KN-D. Thereafter, on September 12, 2020, K15KN-D switched permanently to fiber feed.
