Amended Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule Exhibit
Oregon Public Broadcasting

K04MG-D, Wedderburn, Etc., Oregon, Facility ID No. 13042, was silent pursuant to Special Temporary Authority from January 4, 2021, until February 24, 2021. *See* LMS File No. 0000133843 (Silent STA Request granted Feb. 9, 2021).

On January 4, 2021, K04MG-D was forced off the air resulting from a thermal shutdown due to overheating caused by a broken cooling fan.

Oregon Public Broadcasting (OPB) repaired the cooling fan and returned K04MG-D to air on February 24, 2021. On February 25, 2021, OPB filed a Notice of Resumption for Regular Operations for K04MG-D (LMS File No. 0000137105).

K04MG-D was again silent pursuant to Special Temporary Authority from May 18, 2021, until June 3, 2021. *See* LMS File No. 0000148231 (Silent STA Request granted June 3, 2021).

On May 18, 2021, K04MG-D was once again forced off the air resulting from a failure of the cooling fan.

OPB purchased and installed a new cooling fan and returned K04MG-D to air on June 3, 2021. On June 4, 2021, OPB filed a Notice of Resumption for Regular Operations for K04MG-D (LMS File No. 0000149697).

Finally, K04MG-D was silent for approximately six weeks from April 14, 2022, until May 28, 2022.

On April 14, 2022, K04MG-D was forced off the air resulting from a failure of the station's transmitter. Although repairs were delayed due to the unavailability of parts, the transmitter was rebuilt and K04MG-D returned to air on May 28, 2022.

Due to personnel turnover, OPB inadvertently did not file a timely Silent STA Request related to this period of silence. Once the oversight was discovered, on June 7, 2022, pursuant to staff advice, OPB's FCC counsel filed a letter in the Commission's ECFS filing system, which has now been associated with K04MG-D Facility files in LMS; *see* <https://enterpriseefiling.fcc.gov/dataentry/public/tv/publicFacilityDetails.html?facilityId=13042>.
