

### **Notice of FCC Violations During the Previous Term**

As the Commission is aware, Nexstar Inc.<sup>1</sup> (formerly known as Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc.), licensee and parent entity<sup>2</sup> of 184 full power and Class A television stations, entered into a Consent Decree which resolved the Commission's investigation into whether two Nexstar stations, KARK-TV, Little Rock, Arkansas, FAC ID 33440, and KFDX-TV, Wichita, Texas, FAC ID 65370, served the educational and informational needs of children as required by the Children's Television Act of 1990<sup>3</sup> and satisfied the related filing requirements<sup>4</sup>. More specifically, the Stations collectively failed to air and/or timely report the requisite children's programming. Additionally, several required reports were either late-filed or omitted – resulting in a public inspection file violation.
