

## **EXHIBIT AS TO CHILDREN'S TELEVISION PROGRAMMING REPORTS**

WJAL is submitting this Exhibit in connection with its response to the Children's Television Programming Reports Item in the instant Renewal of License application.

WJAL wishes to inform the Commission that, in preparation of its renewal application, it determined that three of its quarterly Children's Television Programming Reports were inadvertently not submitted on a timely basis.

Pursuant to the directions of the Media Bureau, as contained in the *Public Notice*, DA 19-1186, released November 15, 2019, WJAL has now uploaded the three missing Reports (for Q3 and Q4 of 2017 and Q1 of 2018) to the Additional Documents portion of the Children's Reports section of its public inspection file. It has also uploaded to that Additional Documents section an Explanatory Statement reporting on its failure to upload and advising that it occurred as WJAL was undertaking its post-repack transition, entering into a new channel sharing arrangement, and changing its community of license. These changes, including the major change in the Station's main studio, from Hagerstown to Washington, D.C., and entry into a channel sharing arrangement, resulted in a transition in the management of WJAL from one operating group to another. WJAL believes that during this transitional period, there was confusion as to operating responsibilities resulting in the inadvertent failure to file the three Reports.

WJAL also wishes to note that since the transition was fully completed, all Reports have been timely filed.
