I am writing this as a supplement to my September 14, 2022 letter. In that letter, I attempted to respond to your email of September 2, 2022. To date, no formal letter has been received from your office. I do not know if my September 14, 2022 response has rendered that moot. However, the real purpose of this letter is, once again, to plead with you and the rest of your contemporaries who are involved in this matter to allow the grant of the Engineering STA without prejudice to the outcome of its operational status inquiry. Again, I emphasize that the licensee is under financial distress, which is now heading toward a catastrophic result. I am pleading, on behalf of my client, for relief.

The station has been off the air since July 27, 2022. That means that no income has been generated by that station. My client cannot receive a paycheck if the station is not operating. In

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addition, the citizens of Sioux Falls, South Dakota are being deprived of the programming which was broadcast on the station. Clearly, there are public interest reasons for action to be taken rather than for the Division to purposely drag its feet in order to be vindictive. As more time passes without any action, it reinforces the notion that the financial ruination of my client is the ultimate purpose for the Bureau's callous disregard for the livelihood of my client. Please - I implore you - allow the station to return to the air so that it can resume broadcasting.
