* **Note:** Suffixes are mandatory for Low Power Digital Television (service designation "LPD"; suffix "-LD"), Low Power FM (service designation "FL"; suffix "-LP"), or Digital Class-A (service designation "DCA"; suffix "-CD").

No suffixes are allowed for AM (service designation "AM").

Suffixes may be optional for FM (service designation "FM"; suffix "-FM" or none) and Digital Television (service designation "DTV"; suffix "-TV", "-DT", or none) under certain conditions:

- 1) There cannot be more than one station **with the same service designation** sharing the same initial four letters of a call sign, regardless of appended suffix.
- 2) If there are existing stations with the same initial four letters of their call signs **but different service designations and suffixes**, an eligible station can apply for a four-letter call sign without suffix if the four-letter call sign is available. If the four-letter call sign without suffix has already been registered by another station, then the suffix is mandatory.
