Subject: Oakridge Community Radio - New FM Station KBSR - Reaching out on Behalf of Oregon Public Broadcasting

Gentlemen,

I am reaching out on behalf of our client Oregon Public Broadcasting (OPB).

OPB is the licensee of an FM Translator station licensed to Burns, Oregon (K219BH/K203FP; FCC Facility ID No. 50597), which until recently had been operating on frequency 91.7 MHz. Because of the proximity of 91.7 to the frequency assigned to your new station (91.5 MHz), OPB obtained a "displacement" construction permit from the FCC to switch frequencies for the Translator to 88.5 MHz. OPB has now completed the conversion of its Translator facilities to 88.5 but before the FCC will issue a permanent license to OPB for operations on 88.5, the FCC staff is asking OPB to provide a confirmation from Oakridge Community Radio (OCR) that OCR continues to have plans to construct and launch KBSR on 91.5 (thereby justifying OPB's frequency change).

Would it be possible for you to provide such a confirmation, along with any details you can share about progress in those plans?
