

**AMENDMENT TO LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION**

Maxair Media, LLC (“Maxair”), licensee of television station KNVN(TV), Chico, CA (the “Station”), hereby amends its license renewal application (FCC File No. 0000195407) to respond “No” to the question regarding whether the Station has “complied with the Core Programming criteria and Core Programming Processing Guidelines...” and submits this explanation.

During the 2015-2022 license term,<sup>1</sup> the Station consistently aired make-good episodes in a “second home” time period when an E/I program was preempted. The Station also routinely notified program guides on a weekly basis of all scheduled preemptions such that, when viewers accessed an on-screen programming guide, they would be able to see the date and time that a make-good episode would air. However, due to administrative error, the Station did not consistently provide on-air notification of when make-good episodes would air. To the extent that the Commission would view make-goods that aired without on-air notice as not qualifying as Core programming, Maxair submits that it has nevertheless substantially complied with the Core programming requirement because the Station consistently rescheduled all preempted E/I programming and notified program guide publishers of such rescheduled programming to ensure it was accessible to young viewers.

The Station appreciates the importance of broadcasting programming responsive to the educational and informational needs of children and has trained the staff responsible for addressing preemptions of E/I programming to prevent any issues going forward.
