License Renewal Application
Amendment Explanation

In addition to the originally provided WKBS renewal application online public file explanations, the following additional information is provided in this amendment regarding the station's children's television reports and children's television commercial limits certifications.

After a further review of WKBS's children's television reports filed during the renewal term, the following corrections are provided.

- The average number of hours per week of free over-the-air digital video programming broadcast by the station on other than its main program stream should be 168 hours for the following quarters: Q2 2014 through Q4 2016, and Q3 2017 through Q3 2019. *Note – for Q2 2014 through Q4 2016, Section 73,671(e)(2)(ii) of the rules allowed for the additional 3.0 average hours per week of children's core programming incurred for the additional 168 hours of video programming to be aired on the station's main channel, as is shown in the reports.*
- The 4Q 2019 total hours of core programming aired in the quarter should be 83.5 instead of 84.5.

The following digitally signed certification is provided in connection with WKBS' commercial limits certifications that upon further review were missing certification language or a digital signature:

Certification of Compliance with Children's Television Commercial Limits

I certify that for all of 2021 and 2022, the commercial limits set by the FCC (12 minutes per hour, Monday through Friday, 10/5 minutes per hour on weekends) were not exceeded for the children's programs (ages 12 years and under) contained in the reports/materials covering those periods that were previously and timely uploaded to the public file.
