Dear Former Permittee:

This is with respect to the expired construction permit for the station captioned above. Commission records indicate that you failed to file an application for license to cover for the station by its construction permit expiration date.<sup>1</sup>

Section 73.3598(e) of the Commission's rules states that:

Any construction permit for which construction has not been completed and for which an application for license or extension of time has not been filed, shall be automatically forfeited upon expiration without any further affirmative cancellation by the Commission.<sup>2</sup>

As such, the construction permit was automatically forfeited.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 73.3598(e) of the Commission's rules,<sup>3</sup> the construction permit for the station captioned above was **AUTOMATICALLY FORFEITED** and the call sign has been **DELETED**.<sup>4</sup> All authority to construct the station has been **TERMINATED**.
