Purpose of Application:

North Texas Radio Group, LP (“NTRG”) submits this instant application to extend the existing special temporary authority to operate this facility at reduced power while a suitable site has been found to relocate the multi tower directional array required to return the facility to operation. NTRG closed on this facility on 5-10-23 and was able to get the temporary site authorized in the STA above operational by 7-20-2023. At that time a resumption of operation was filed with the Commission. NTRG has been diligently searching for a new site to relocate the directional antenna system required to relicense this facility. See the following pages to see some details of the progress of this search.

Technical:

As authorized in the original STA, the facility is inside a fenced area which is locked from the inside. Access to the gates is from inside the house on the property. The facility is twenty five or more feet from any structures with the exception of a detached garage on the property which itself is locked and is a barrier to public access. The existing STA operates with 100 Watts using a center loaded whip antenna mounted on a 10 foot Rohn tower section. The “one size fits all” choices in the LMS form does not allow for an accurate explanation of this antenna, so please disregard anything from the form that contradicts what was granted in the original STA. This request is identical to the previously granted STA. Complete details of the previous STA are attached as an exhibit.

STATEMENT OF RICHARD WITKOVSKI NEW SITE PROGRESS

Began work on 5-10-23 after purchase was closed and notice of consummation was filed with FCC.

Met with director of engineering for Estrella, the previous owner. Went to the site where all items that were included with the station and inventoried them.

5-11 Began work on procuring materials for implementing STA that was filed at our request by Estrella to return facility to air under STA.

5-15 Drove for 7 hours to 9 sites being considered for new trans site. Some in flood zones some on Farms.

5-18 visited directional sites of other stations to investigate for diplexing of 1540.

5-23 Visited with owners and engineers of KKDA, KMNY, and KFXR.

5-29 Commissioned study of site in Dallas which allowed for 50 kw on two towers.

6-5 Visited with Dr. Arango, owner of 870 about duplexing. He does not own the land.

6-10 Construction of STA site underway in city of license

6-21 Drove 64 miles up and down Beltline east Lone star park interviewing owners of site that might be acceptable.

6-23 Visited Lonestar Park and got owners names for further interviews.

7-1 Contacted Indian Nations that have 9 Radio Stations about interest in using their land here in Mid-Cities for two tower directional location.

7-9 Met with Gov Annatubby of the Choctaw Nation on Land lease at Lone Star Park.

7-15 Went to 570/1310 Site where they are diplexed.

7-20 Went to site on non- flooding site north side of Belt Line owned by Alaska Co. Visited with owners about towers going there.

7-21 Visited site at Frankfort and Stemmons where a tower is located with about 15 acres of land.

7-24 Drove 44 miles in and around the Mid Cities looking at land that might be for sale or lease.

8-3 Back with presentation to KKDA owners and the diplexing possibility.

8-11 More contact with City of Dallas on flood zone on Luna where KVIL AM was previously located until about 20 years ago.

8-16 Met with Golf Pro at golf club owned by City to confirm they had no plans to use the 80 acres of flood zoned land.

8-22 Visited site in Lewisville where an FM has an Aux site. 45 acres of non-flood landowner by local farmer. This location was determined to be too far north to be useful. During the months of September and Oct. I spent effort on City of Dallas Land Lease. Multiple visits to the site locating availability of 3 phase power and access for tower crews to move in and out.

I have had multiple phone and email visits with City Park employees Deirdre Craig, Vega Martinez, and a personal visit to City Hall with Jason Ney, Manager of Park Planning. This is the ideal site as it was once used for a 6 tower AM KVIL for over 40 years. There have been many other sites investigated but we determined they were not suitable for our use. This gives you the general effort I have made to this task. Many more options are available and once we receive our new STA extension I will get back on the road.
