

**WCCA, INC. LEGAL CERTIFICATIONS**  
**and**  
**COMMUNITY-BASED CRITERIA**

The applicant was formed on January 26, 1987 and has been in continuous existence since that date. While it is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation with an educational mission, it is not an educational institution, *per se*. It was founded in order to provide community and public access to media by operating the local community access cable channel in Worcester. Indeed, it was operating as such for at least a year prior to being incorporated in Massachusetts as a non-profit organization. Its facilities are in the center of the City of Worcester, and are readily accessible to residents of Worcester and surrounding area.

The applicant proposes to operate the new LPFM so as to provide synergy with its cable TV operation, and from co-located radio facilities. This will facilitate employing the new station to expand its educational mission and programming. It will also extend its reach beyond the medium of television, and to residents who have “cut the cable.”

The applicant provides education and training to members of the public in order to facilitate knowledgeable access to its cable TV facilities, and to enable members of the public to create their own programming. Some of these programs circa 2023, as well as a few of the specific educational opportunities available to the general public, are noted in the exhibit entitled “WCCA Program Listing 2023.” Similar education and training will be extended to the medium of radio broadcasting by way of the new LPFM, and offered to the public.

As shown in the Listing of Parties to the Application, 100% of the eight Directors live in the City of Worcester, or within 13 km in the case of Dr. Nguyen in North Grafton.
